The NAMC New York Tri-State Chapter Scholarship Program has been formulated to encourage and motivate studies for minority students in the field of Engineering and Architectural. It is the Chapter's mission in bridging the gap between minority students and the construction industry, through advocacy, access and training. Scholarships of \$1,000.00 each will be awarded to students of minority descent.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ Must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program in Engineering and Architecture related field from an institution with in the Tri-State region
- ❖ Undergraduates must be in their 3rd or 4th year
- ❖ A minimum overall GPA of 3.0 is required (transcript required)
- Scholarship applicants are required to become a NAMC New York Tristate Student Chapter member, which will be advised by the executive board members. (Student membership fee \$20 payable online, membership forms are available by emailing secretary@namctristate.org)
- Applicants must write an essay of 500 words stating; why they are deserving of this scholarship and what inspired their studies of engineering and architecture.
- Must submit Student Membership form, Transcript and Essay by October 7th
- ❖ Awardees must be present in person during the NAMC New York Tri-State Unity in Diversity Gala on October 18th at The Grand Hyatt to receive scholarship
